

Deferring Your Practical Training

DEFERRAL PROCEDURE AND POLICY | Sports Therapy UK 2018

1. If a Course Applicant/Course Student is unable to attend part of the practical training,
 - 1.1. they may arrange individual tuition with a course tutor from Sports Therapy UK before the continuation of the course enrolled upon, at a fee to be agreed with Sports Therapy UK. This will be offered on a weekday or weekend, subject to tutor availability.
 - 1.2. For more specific details concerning situations where you may not be able to attend the final part of your practical training, please refer to **Completing My Course** on Page 7 of our Course Guide.
2. If the Course Applicant/Course Student is unable to attend individual tuition described in No 1. above;
 - 2.1. They may apply to Sports Therapy UK to defer and continue another course, subject to availability of places, and for which a course transfer fee will be payable.
 - 2.2. In the event of the above, a period of 4 months or more between the most recent practical training attended and the recommencement on a deferred date will be allowed, after which we may require the student attends part, or all the practical training previously attended to help prepare for assessments.
 - 2.3. Students who have already taken and passed any observed practical assessments will not be reassessed.
 - 2.4. The above recommendation is to ensure that you receive the correct training and content required for your assessments.
 - 2.5. In the event of a Course Applicant/Course Student transferring to another course, we do not guarantee that the content of each day will remain the same. Courses may be altered in accordance with student feedback and developed following our own course reviews.
